What We Do



Our History

WRMSDC was founded on September 9, 1977, almost 10 years after the Civil Rights Movement that sparked national aware ness about racial discrimination and segregation in the United States. Galvanized by the unequal treatment of minority-owned businesses, the Council began serving as advocates for impacted minority communities in Northern California, Hawai'i, and Nevada.

Our Impact

We directly impact the employment, labor income, tax base, and economy in Northern California, Nevada, and Hawai'i. Every year, our minority businesses create over 760,000 jobs, generate over \$11.3B in revenue, and contribute over \$687.7M in taxes. Our local Corporate Members spend over \$3B with diverse suppliers, train over 300 minority businesses, and volunteer over 900 hours in support of minority businesses.
